Each Area Agency on Aging (AAA) in Ohio must submit a four-year Strategic Area Plan (SAP) to the Ohio Department of Aging (AGE). The SAP is a written document containing the strategy to provide for the development and implementation of a comprehensive and coordinated service delivery system for services to older individuals in our service area. Progress related to the SAP is updated annually and AAAs have the opportunity to make revisions throughout the four-year period. AGE provides a framework that the AAAs must follow in developing the SAP. This public hearing provides an opportunity for the aging network and the public to provide comments on the strategic elements of the plan.
