How To Get Help From **PASSPORT**

- Anyone looking for information about long-term service and support options can call PASSPORT at 216.621.0303 or 1.800.626.7277.
- A screener helps the caller identify their long-term service and support needs, including possible eligibility for PASSPORT in-home services.
- If desired, an in-person assessment visit will be scheduled and conducted by a licensed social worker or registered nurse free of charge.
- For those eligible for PASSPORT in-home services, a care plan is developed and services are arranged through PASSPORT provider agencies.
- For those who are not eligible for PASSPORT, assistance is provided to obtain other support services.



PASSPORT is a service of the Western Reserve Area Agency on Aging (WRAAA) and is jointly administered by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services and the Ohio Department of Aging.

WRAAA serves Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain and Medina counties.

Eligibility For *PASSPORT* In-Home Services

- 60 years of age or older
- Eligible for Medicaid
- Live in a home or apartment
- Need hands-on help with daily activities such as bathing, dressing and meals
- Agree to accept PASSPORT services
- Doctor's agreement that PASSPORT services are needed
- Have basic health and safety needs met
- Maintain a cost for PASSPORT services at or below 60% of the cost of nursing home care

Each PASSPORT participant has a Care Manager who works with the consumer and their family to coordinate in-home services and to maintain regular contact with each other and PASSPORT provider agencies.
